

Crime Bulletin and District Update (January 2018)

On 01/01/2018, the Colma Fire Department and the Broadmoor Police Department responded to a vehicle leaking fluid on the 400 block of Park Plaza Drive. The fluid was discovered to be diesel fuel and was later removed from the street.

On 01/01/2018, Officer Segali conducted a traffic enforcement stop. A records check revealed the driver was driving while suspended. The driver was cited and released on scene.

On 01/02/2018, several commercial vehicles were cited on the 400 block of Park Plaza Drive. During parking enforcement, several vehicles were towed pursuant to California Vehicle Code violations.

On 01/02/2018, Officer Yanga contacted a pedestrian at the intersection of El Camino Real and Albert M. Teglia for jaywalking. The subject who was on probation was searched. A bag of narcotics was located and the subject was placed under arrest.

On 01/03/2018, Officer Segali and Officer Logan responded to a disturbance at the 7-11 convenience store. After an extensive investigation, Officer's discovered the customer had used counterfeit money to make a purchase. The suspect was later located and arrested.

On 01/03/2018, Officer Yanga contacted a subject who was loitering in front of the 7-11 convenience store. Homeless outreach resources as well as medical services were provided to the subject, who was later transported to Mills Peninsula for mental illness.

On 01/04/2018, Officer Segali conducted a traffic enforcement stop and discovered that the driver was driving without a valid driver's license. The driver was cited and released on scene.

On 01/04/2018, Officer Segali and Officer Logan contacted a subject at Colma Bart. Officers later discovered the subject had a warrant for his arrest. The subject was also in possession of narcotics. The subject was placed under arrest and transported to jail.

On 01/06/2018, Officer Hekker conducted a traffic enforcement stop on Park Plaza Drive. Further investigation revealed the driver was driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of marijuana. The driver was later arrested.

On 01/06/2018, Officer Landi responded to a home in Broadmoor on a report of an assault between roommates. The case has been forwarded to the District Attorney's Office.

On 01/06/2018, Officer Hekker conducted a traffic enforcement stop and discovered that the driver was driving without a valid driver's license. The driver was cited and released on scene.

On 01/07/2018, Officer Logan and Officer Segali were on patrol when they witnessed a non-injury collision in Daly City. Officers stopped and assisted. During the course of the

investigation, it was discovered that one driver did not have a valid driver's license. The driver was issued a citation and released on scene.

On 01/09/2018, Officer Logan and Segali conducted a traffic enforcement stop in Daly City. The driver was found to be driving without a valid driver's license. The driver was later cited and released from the scene.

On 01/09/2018, Officer Yanga responded to a home in Broadmoor on report of a verbal domestic disturbance. Officers arrived on scene, and provided resources to both parties who ultimately declined any help. Officers gave advice to both parties and remained on scene until one party left the home for the remainder of the day.

On 01/10/2018, Officer Morton and Deputy Moore responded to the Royal Donuts store located at 7438 El Camino Real on a report of a subject breaking store windows. Upon arrival, Officers discovered that the subject had fled. The subject was later located and positively identified as the suspect by the shop owner. The subject who initially gave a false name to Police was later positively identified and placed under arrest. The subject was transported to County Jail.

On 01/11/2018, Officer Hekker conducted a traffic enforcement stop along the 300 block of Park Plaza Drive. Further investigation revealed that the driver was operating a motor vehicle with a suspended driver's license for DUI. The driver was cited and released on scene.

On 01/11/2018, Officer Landi conducted a traffic enforcement stop along 87th Street in Broadmoor. An investigation revealed that the driver was suspected of operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol, marijuana, or a combination of both. The driver was later arrested and his vehicle was towed.

The driver was later arrested and his vehicle was towed.

On 01/17/2018, Officer Reid and Segali responded to a home in Broadmoor regarding a subject with suicidal thoughts. Upon arrival, Officers offered resources to the subject and she was ultimately transported to Mills Peninsula hospital for further evaluation.

01/18/2018, Officer Landi and Officer Hekker responded to Blue Water Towing on a report of a disturbance regarding the total cost of a vehicle tow and storage fees. Officers arrived on scene and ultimately resolved the issue between customers and representatives from the tow yard.

On 01/20/2018, Officer Hekker conducted a traffic enforcement stop on a vehicle that was weaving between lanes. Upon contact, Officer Hekker noticed the distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the driver's person. The driver was later placed under arrest for suspicion of operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol.

On 01/21/2018, Officer Hekker conducted a traffic enforcement stop. The driver was later found to be operating a motor vehicle on a suspended driver's license. The driver was cited and then released from the scene.

On 01/21/2018, Officer Hekker conducted a traffic enforcement stop near 87th Street and Park Plaza Drive in Broadmoor. The driver was later arrested on suspicion of operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol. The driver's vehicle was later towed from the scene.

On 01/24/2018, Officer Landi conducted a traffic enforcement stop on a vehicle. With the assistance of the California Highway Patrol, the driver was arrested for suspicion of driving while intoxicated.

On 01/26/2018, Officer Hekker conducted a traffic enforcement stop along Park Plaza Drive and 87th Street. The driver was arrested for suspicion of driving while intoxicated.

On 01/26/2018, Officer Morton responded to 7800 El Camino Real, La Terrazza Apartments on a report of multiple vehicles being burglarized. The investigation is ongoing.

On 01/26/2018, Officer Hekker responded to 7440 El Camino Real on a report of an assault and battery. A report was completed and was forwarded to the San Mateo County Office of the District Attorney for review.

On 01/28/2018, Officer Hekker conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle. Following an investigation, the driver was arrested for suspicion of driving while intoxicated.

On 01/28/2018, Officer Hekker conducted a traffic stop on the 1900 block of Junipero Serra Blvd. in Daly City. Following an investigation, the driver was arrested for suspicion of driving while intoxicated.

On 01/28/2018, Officer Reid responded to an armed robbery on Stoneyford Drive. The suspects asked for directions, pointed a gun at the victim after her attention was diverted, and then stole a purse.

In the month of January, the Broadmoor Police Department has made over 15 arrests for DUI, in an effort to ensure the safety for motorists and pedestrians on Broadmoor streets.
