

### **Crime Bulletin and District Update (February 2018)**

On 02/01/2018, Officer Morton and Deputy Moore responded to the 700 block on a report of a fight. Officers arrived on scene and stopped the verbal altercation. Both parties were separated and offered resources.

On 02/01/2018, Officer Morton responded to Ben Franklin School on a report of a fight between two students. After an investigation, a case report was generated and forwarded to the San Mateo County Office of the District Attorney for their review.

On 02/01/2018, a theft of a motorcycle helmet and vandalism occurred on the 7600 block of El Camino Real. Officers are in the process of obtaining surveillance footage of the theft and the investigation is ongoing.

On 02/04/2018, Officer Landi arrested a subject for disorderly conduct (drunk in public). The subject was later transported to County Jail.

On 02/04/2018, after receiving parking complaints from residents along the 400 block of Park Plaza Drive, Officer Segali towed several vehicles and issued several parking citations.

On 02/04/2018, Officer Segali and Officer Logan conducted a traffic enforcement stop after the driver was observed talking on a cell phone. The driver was later arrested on suspicion of operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol and was arrested.

On 02/04/2018, Deputy Brandt stopped an individual for acting erratic near the intersection of Albert Teglia and El Camino Real. The subject was later found to be in possession of drug paraphernalia and controlled substances. The subject was arrested and cited.

On 02/05/2018, Deputy Brandt was on patrol in Broadmoor when he observed a subject near Colma Bart. Upon contact, the subject was found to have an arrest warrant. The subject was also in possession of drug paraphernalia. The subject was arrested and transported to County Jail.

On 02/06/2018, a theft of a basketball hoop was reported to the Broadmoor Police Department. Surveillance footage is currently being reviewed for any suspect information.

Between 02/09/18 – 02/11/18, the Broadmoor Police department have made several arrests on drivers for driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs.

On 02/11/18, Officer Reid contacted a subject with several warrants from different police agencies throughout the county on A St. The subject was ultimately placed under arrest and transported to Maguire Correctional Facility.

On 02/16/18, a vehicle was damaged when the window was broken by an unknown person(s) in the area of 87<sup>th</sup> Street and Park Plaza Drive.

On 02/17/18, Officer Yanga conducted a traffic enforcement stop on a vehicle at Junipero Serra Blvd. and Southgate Avenue. The driver was contacted and later found to have an arrest warrant for his arrest as well as a suspended driver's license. The driver was placed under arrest and was later cited and released on scene.

On 02/18/18, Deputy Brandt contacted a subject near Albert M. Teglia and El Camino Real. A records check revealed the subject had an arrest warrant and was placed under arrest.

On 02/19/2018, an unknown person stole the contents of a tip jar at the City Café. A check of the area revealed that the subject had stolen the contents of the tip jar at Royal Donuts. The investigation is ongoing as to the identity of the individual and a county wide alert has been sent in an attempt to identify him.

On 02/19/2018, Officer Reid conducted a traffic enforcement stop on a vehicle near 87<sup>th</sup> Street and Maddux Drive. The driver was found to be driving without a valid driver's license.

On 02/20/2018, a hit and run collision occurred on the 500 block of Midway Avenue in Broadmoor.

On 02/21/2018, an unknown suspect took three pairs of sunglasses out of an unlocked vehicle that was parked on the 300 block of Clark Avenue in Broadmoor.

On 02/23/18, BPD placed a subject under arrest for outstanding arrest warrants after she caused a disturbance at the Hillside Market.

On 02/24/18, an unknown suspect stole the contents of a tip jar at the Royal Donuts. The theft was captured on surveillance and the investigation is ongoing.

On 02/24/18, BPD conducted two separate traffic enforcements stops. Both drivers were ultimately arrested for driving while under the influence of alcohol.

On 02/24/18, Officers responded to the 900 block of Foothill Drive. An unknown suspect(s) damaged the driver's side mirror on a vehicle that was parked.

On 02/26/17, a shooting occurred at the Hillside Market in Broadmoor, where two victims ultimately succumbed to their injuries. The suspects were later located and arrested. (See Press Release for further information).
