A RESOLUTION SPECIFYING AND
SETTING HOLIDAYS TO BE
HONORED BY THE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the District has not adopted a formal schedule of holidays it will honor and observe; and,

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Understanding between the District and the Broadmoor Police Officer's Association provides a list of holidays the District must honor for all represented employees; and,

WHEREAS, the Holiday Schedule set forth in the Memorandum of Understanding applies only to represented employees of the District and does not apply to unrepresented employees or the District as a public entity; and,

WHEREAS, in order to maintain efficiency and provide for a consistent and reliable operation of the District, it is imperative that a formal Holiday Schedule should be adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

SECTION 1. The following days are official holidays of the District, which shall be honored and observed as such, viz:

New Year's Day (January)
Martin Luther King Day (January)
President's Day (February)
Cesar Chavez Day (March)
Memorial Day (May)
Juneteenth (June)
Independence Day (July)
Labor Day (September)
Indigenous Peoples Day (October)
Veteran's Day (November)
Thanksgiving Day (November)
The day after Thanksgiving (November)
Christmas Day (December)
Every day proclaimed by the President of the United States as a holiday
Every day proclaimed by the Governor of California as a holiday
Every day proclaimed by the Board of Police Commissioners as a holiday


SECTION 2. The provisions of this Resolution are retroactive to January 1, 2026.


